I. Course Description

This course is designed to provide English advanced students a level of higher achievement by integrating oral and written communication skills through a variety of genre such as essays, short stories, and poetry. Vocabulary and grammar will be integrated in the course activities. Student performance will be assessed through a variety of performance activities. Proficiency will be expected in the use of technology in order to record and produce documents that will help students attain independence as a literate person in an ever-changing global community.

II. Course Objectives

By the end of the school year, the students will be able to do the following:

- 1. Communicate effectively in formal and informal speech situations and speak with greater fluency.
- 2. Express thoughts in grammatically correct sentences and phrases in both oral and written form.
- Improve comprehension and analytical skills though the reading of brief nonfiction and fictional works.
- 4. Use essay models as the basis for further development of composition skills.
- 5. Use, interpret and analyze audiovisual media.
- 6. Use word processing and publishing software to create documents.

- 1. Read informational texts.
- 2. Identify main ideas, characters, themes, setting, and plot in a literary text.
- 3. Edit and publish a final product.
- 4. Read and interpret selected poems.
- 5. Identify figurative language.
- Analyze Imagery.

- 8. Apply correct grammar and vocabulary in writing.
