

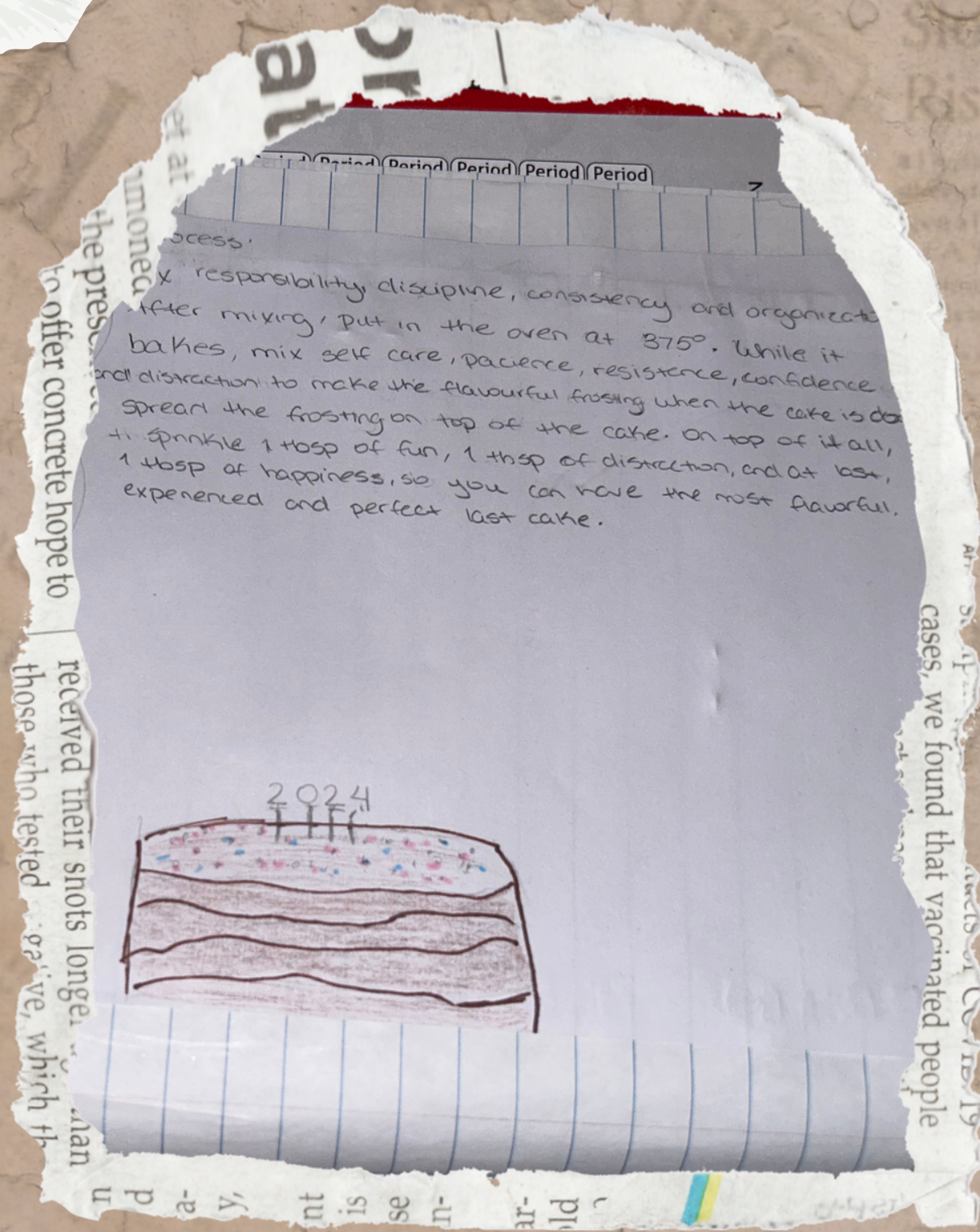

August 7th, 2023

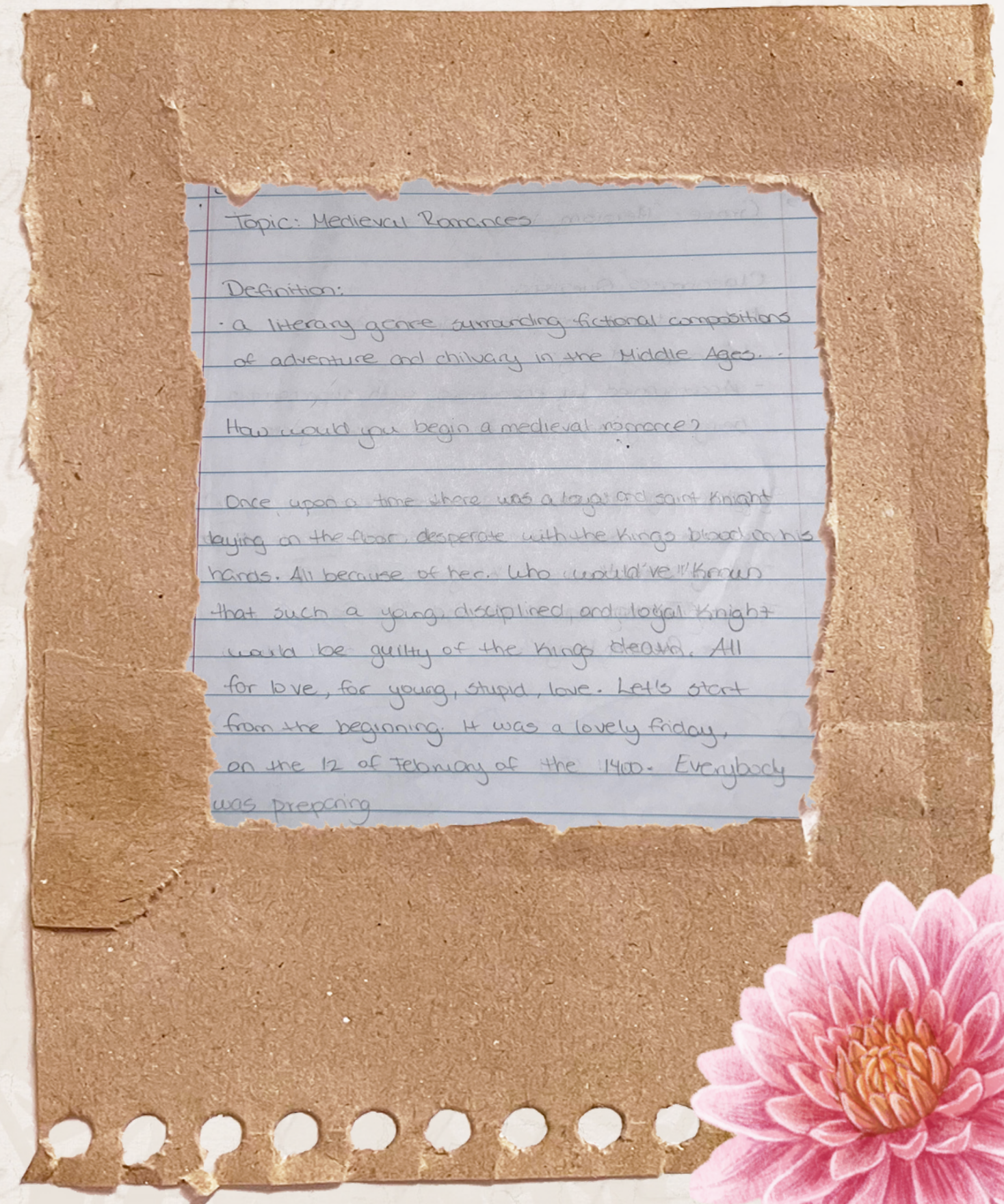
My favorite part of this class was doing our personal recipe for senior year.

August 16, 2023



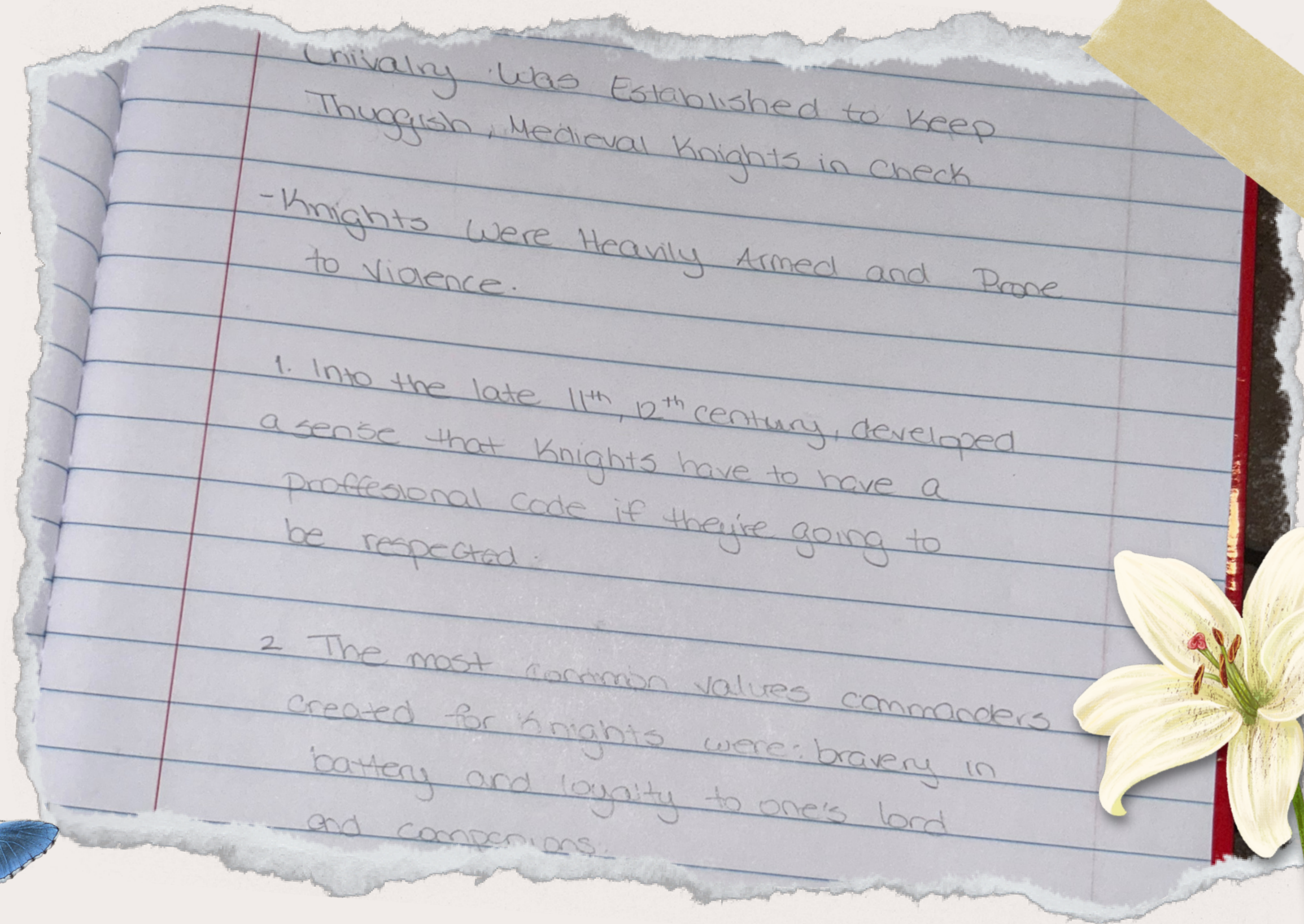
