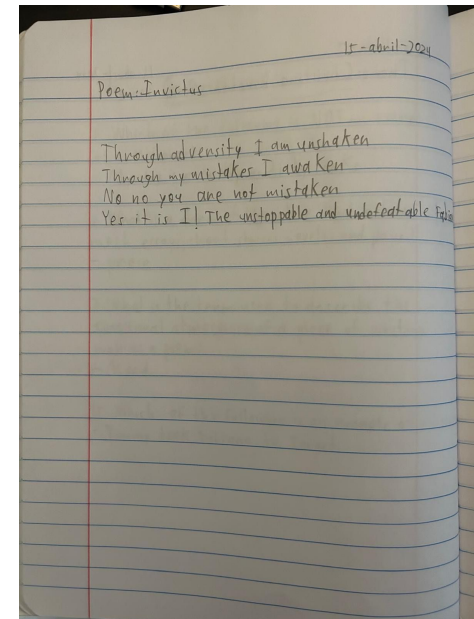
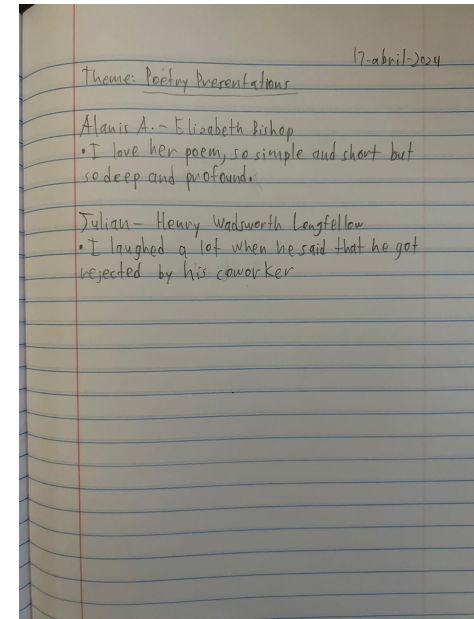


Class Activities

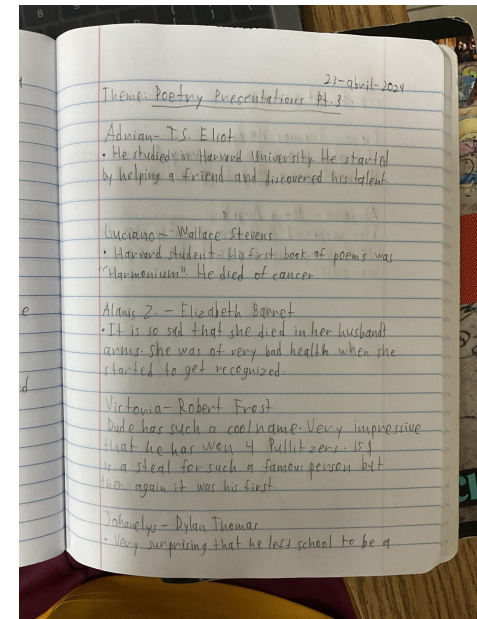
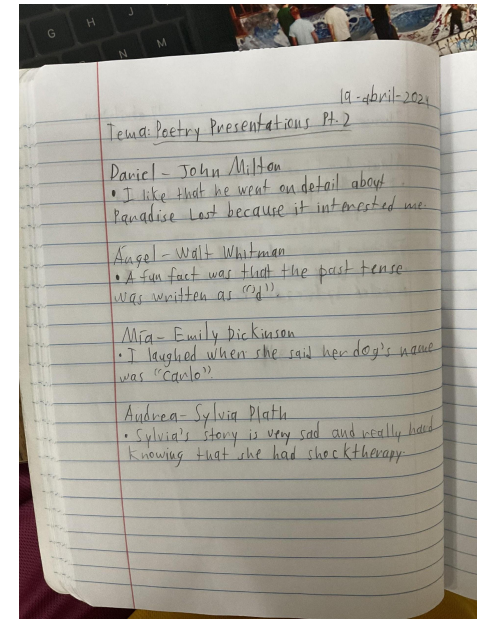
April 15 and 17, 2024

How to jump rope correctly

Materials: Jump rope- any jump rope as long as it fits you.

How do you know if the jump rope fits you?

Step on the middle of the jump rope with your feet together.

Pull the rope up toward your shoulders until it's tight.

The end of the cable (not including the handles) should reach your sternum or armpits.

1. Position: stand straight and arms to the side, rope on the floor and backwards
2. Technique:
 - Jump with both legs
 - Use your wrists, not your forearms
 - Loosen up
 - Light feet
3. Tips and tricks:
 - Jump when the rope is reaching your legs
 - Don't wait for the rope to come down, jump as if you were anticipating it

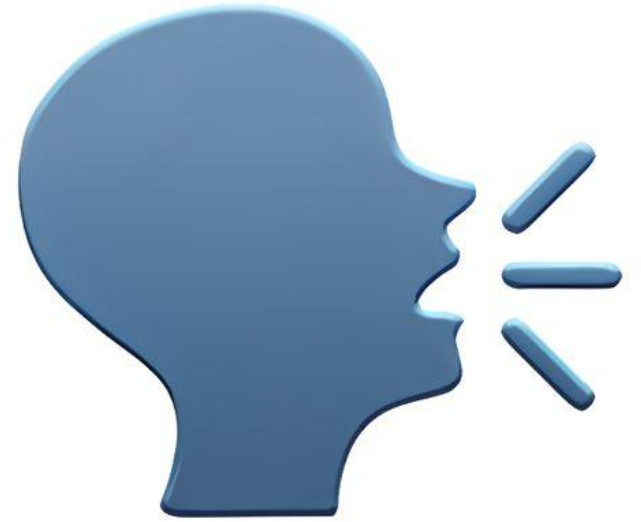
