


# INTRODUCTION

# APRIL 15 & 17


April 15 – Learn about William Ernest Henley and we did a poem, it was fun and I think it was the easiest poem I did form the hundreds I did before.


April 17 - I was absent because I had an appointment but I sadly miss 3 of the presentations of the poets.






## APRIL 19 & 23


April 19 - We keep we the presentations the whole class, we had short periods so it was pretty fast and only dedicated the class for 3 powerpoints.


April 23 - We finally finished our presentations and also did mine







May 1- We started our presentations and I think I'm going to end up having a tiny business for my oreo cheesecake.






# CONCLUSION
