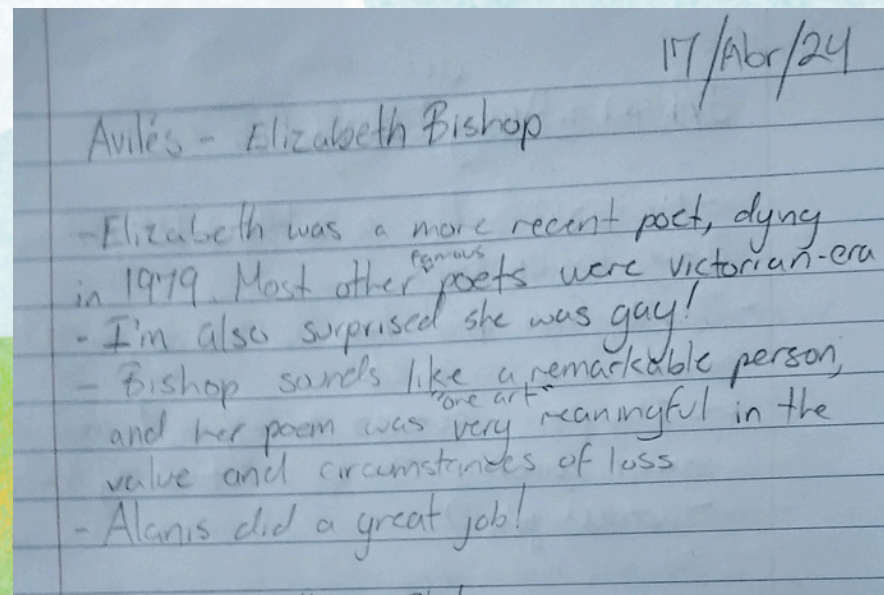
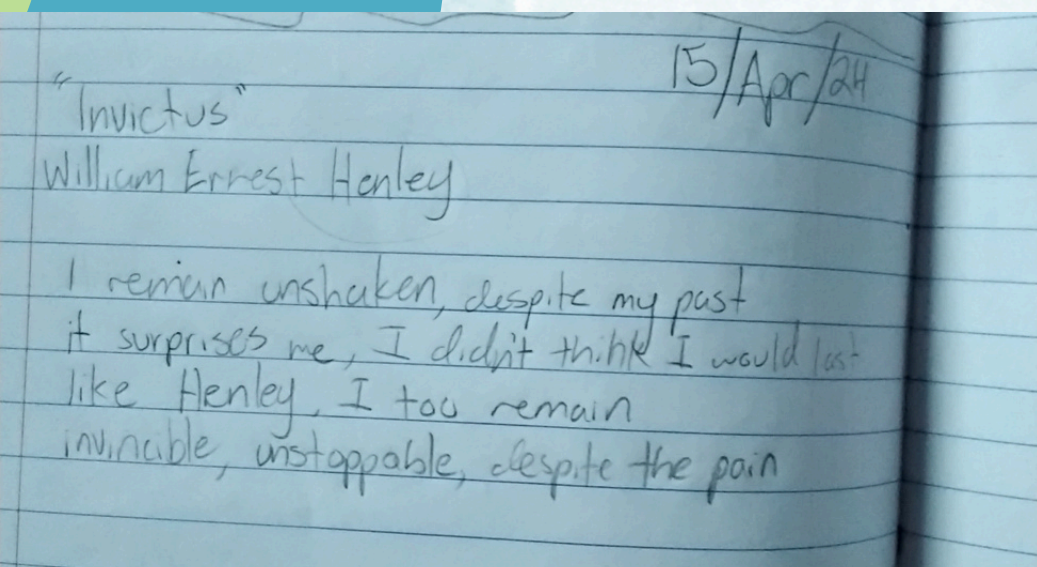




# 15th + 17th of April

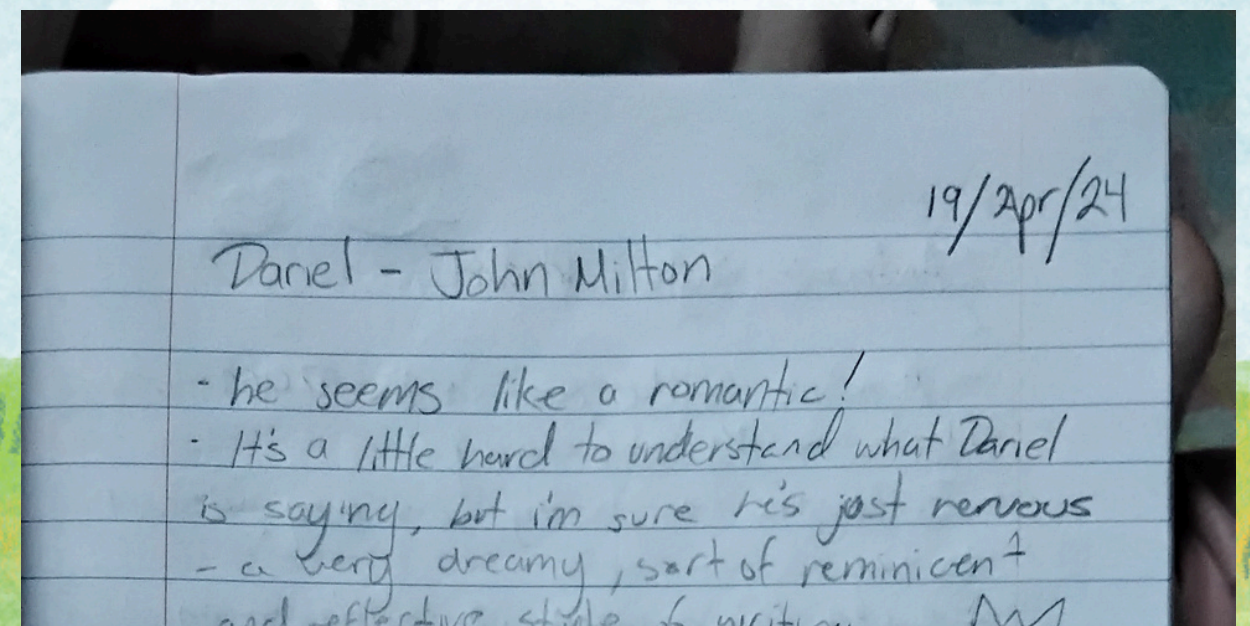
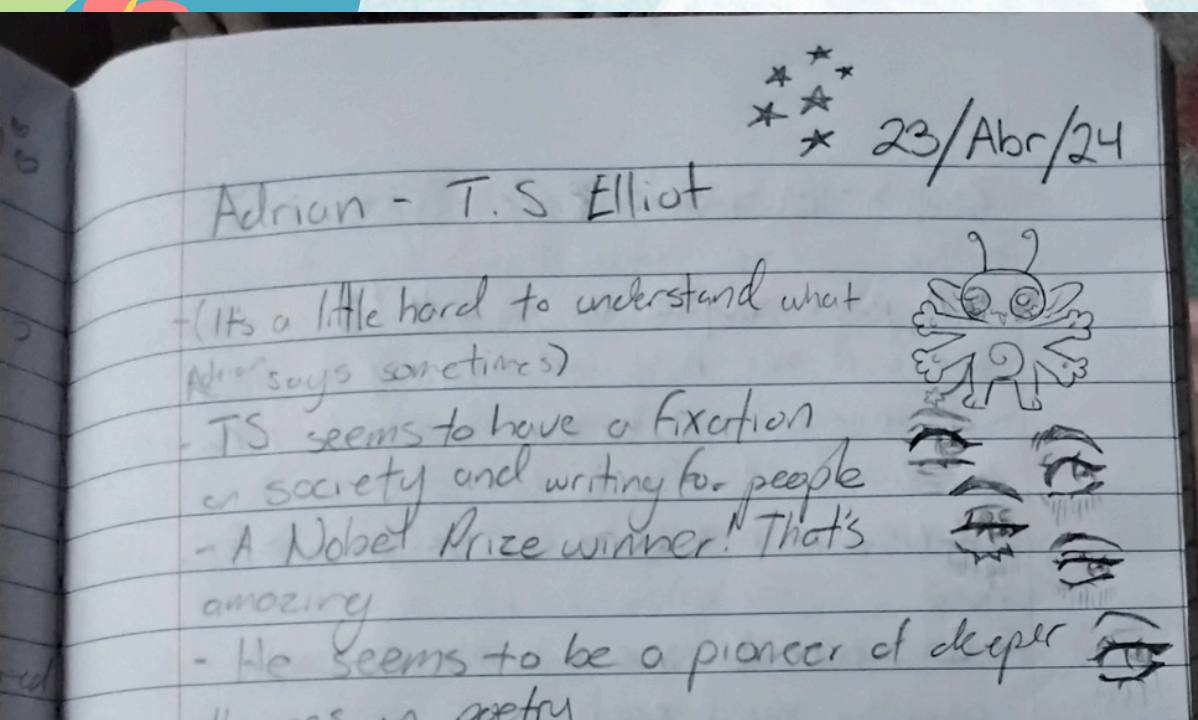




# 19th + 23rd of April
